Ladies' Program for Four Corners Royal Arch Festival
Winslow, Arizona
Saturday, October 5, 2019

This will be a wonderful Saturday to take it easy in historic downtown Winslow. There is always a fine sight to see and the best part is that most things are free or at little cost. The weather this time of year is typically characterized by cool early mornings and warm afternoons. The sun will probably be bright, so don't forget to bring a wide brimmed hat, sunscreen, possibly a water bottle, and wear comfortable shoes.

The day will begin about 8 a.m. for coffee and donuts with the men at the Winslow Masonic Temple. The building was destroyed by an arson fire in October 2014 and has been beautifully restored. A self-guided wander through this lovely building is encouraged.

We will begin exploring Winslow at 9 a.m. with a visit to the historic and remarkably well-preserved Hubbell building. This former trading post is now home of the Winslow Chamber of Commerce Visitor's Center. There are many interesting historic photos and artifacts to see and admission is free. Bring a shopping bag – Saturdays are Mother Road Farmer's Market day at the Chamber

We'll next visit the magnificent La Posada Hotel. This 1929 former Harvey House was designed by architect Mary Jane Colter, designer of many buildings at the Grand Canyon. Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, it has been lovingly restored to its former glory. It now serves as a hotel and art gallery, and features lovely manicured grounds, a gourmet restaurant, and a gift shop with beautiful handcrafted items reflecting Arizona's many cultures.



We will then return to the center of downtown Winslow and the famous "Standin' on the Corner" Park. This popular site was made famous by the classic hit song by the Eagles, "Take it Easy." You won't want to miss an opportunity to take a picture on the corner with the statue of Glen Frey and the flatbed Ford!

Just across the street from "the corner" is The Old Trails Museum/Winslow Historical Society, which opens at 10 a.m. This museum displays more of historic Winslow in photos, memorabilia, and exhibits. Admission is free or donation.



The Just Cruisin' Car Show is also taking place in downtown Winslow this weekend. The show features vintage hot rods, antique vehicles, and classic muscle cars. You won't want to miss a chance to see these beautifully cared for classic autos!

There are also quaint shops in old Winslow to purchase a souvenir or maybe stop for a cold or hot beverage or an ice cream treat.

Lunch will be with the men back at Winslow Lodge about noon. After lunch you will be on your own to return to your hotel in Holbrook or to walk the two blocks back to old downtown Winslow to continue exploring on your own.

Lodging for Four Corners Royal Arch Festival

The site hotel for the 2019 Four Corners Royal Arch Festival will be in **Holbrook** at the **Best Western “Arizonian Inn”, 2508 E. Navajo Blvd. Holbrook, 86025**. The special rate for the event is **\$89.99 per night** (+9.94 tax = \$99.93/night) for Friday, October 4th and Saturday, October 5th, checking out on October 6th. This is a beautifully maintained hotel and features a full course hot breakfast included with the special rate. There is also a Denny’s Restaurant right next to the hotel. To reserve your room, contact the hotel at **928-524-2611** and mention the “**Four Corners Royal Arch Festival special rate**” registered under “**Peter Johnson**”.

It was necessary to move the site hotel to Holbrook due to the Just Cruisin’ Car Show scheduled in Winslow the same weekend as our Festival. The more upscale hotels in Winslow were charging “event rates” of \$150.00 or more, so it made a lot of sense to move the site hotel to Holbrook. We are sorry for any inconvenience this decision may have caused.

The Best Western Hotel in Holbrook is also close to many fast food outlets. Other close by restaurants include the Cameleon (casual Mexican), Mesa Italiano (exceptional food), and Mandarin Beauty (casual Chinese). In downtown Holbrook there are two Mexican eateries favored by locals, El Rancho on Navajo Blvd. and Romo’s on Hopi Blvd.

Winslow Lodge #13, F. and A.M.

Site of the 55th Annual Four Corners Royal Arch Festival

On October 10, 2014 the complete interior of the lovely Winslow Masonic Temple was destroyed in an arson fire perpetrated by three young men. A local dry-cleaning establishment and abandoned civic building were also destroyed. Winslow Lodge was chartered in 1896 and the Winslow Temple was erected in 1923. The loss, which included elaborate lodge furniture and over a century of accumulated regalia for the blue lodge, Order of the Eastern Star, and York Rite, was in the millions.

Thanks to insurance the Lodge has been rebuilt and restored to its original grandeur. Much of the regalia has also been replaced. The newly renovated Temple was rededicated by the Grand Lodge of Arizona in May of 2017. The paraphernalia of Temple Chapter #8, Royal Arch Masons, chartered in 1903, was also nearly completely destroyed in the fire of 2014. The costumes and banners of the Chapter have been meticulously recreated, and the Chapter is now back on its feet.
